## Traffic switch at Chatsworth Road South and Serpentine Channel North Bank Road, Chatsworth Island on Thursday 31 August

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the \$4.36 billion Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade. Roads and Maritime Services Pacific Highway Office and Pacific Complete are working together to deliver the project.

A new diversion road at Chatsworth Road South and Serpentine Channel North Bank Road for local traffic is almost complete. Local traffic will now be switched onto the new diversion road on **Thursday 31 August** between **7am and 6pm**, weather permitting.

A map has been provided to explain this change. This traffic arrangement for local traffic is temporary and will allow us to maintain capacity on the road network while we safely build the new carriageway for the highway upgrade. Highway traffic will not be affected by this traffic switch.

The new diversion road is located about 40 metres north of the existing intersection of Chatsworth Road South, Serpentine Channel North Bank Road and the Pacific Highway, Chatsworth Island. The eastern side of this diversion road will form part of the final Chatsworth Road South overpass for the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade. The western side is temporary and will be removed when the project is finished.


## **Traffic changes**

There will be some temporary changes while this work is carried out. Lane closures and signage will be in place and the speed limit will be reduced to 40 kilometres/hour, this may affect travel times. Motorists may notice increased truck movements in the area while the work is carried out. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
