

Work outside approved construction hours on Woodburn Evans Head Road, Woodburn

Roads and Maritime Services, Pacific Complete and its contractor partners are working together to deliver the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade.

As part of completing the overpass bridge on Woodburn Evans Head Road, the project team will be working outside approved construction hours. This work is for technical reasons and planned between 6pm and 7am for 11 nights between Monday 11 to Friday 29 March, weather permitting, in preparation for the traffic to move permanently onto the new section of Woodburn Evans Head Road on Monday 18 March, weather permitting.



Work hours

Typically work will be carried out during the project's approved construction hours, which are:

Approved construction hours	
Monday to Friday 7am–6pm	
Saturday 8am–5pm	

In areas where residents live more than 200 metres from the work, extended work hours are allowed between 6am and 7am and 6pm and 7pm from Monday to Friday. No work will be carried on Sunday or a public holiday.

Work outside approved construction hours

The work outside of approved construction hours is planned between 6pm and 7am for up to 11 nights from Monday 11 March to Friday 29 March 2019, weather permitting. This work is required to connect the overpass to Woodburn Evans Head Road and will involve asphaltting, paving, line marking and installing safety barriers, road signage and furniture.

There are technical reasons why this work is required outside approved construction hours, which include:

- **Safety** – making it safer for motorists and workers when we are building over and next to roads by reducing interactions between these two groups.
- **Traffic** – building next to, over and on existing roads, means traffic may be stopped or reduced to one lane while work is carried out.

How we manage our work

The project team will use machinery that generates noise, light and vibration. To manage this work, we will:

- turn-off machinery when not in use
- direct temporary lighting down and away from homes
- plan activities close to residents to coincide with normal construction hours, where possible
- fit equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly reversing squawkers







- monitor noise so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work as required.

All work will be carried out in line with the project's Conditions of Approval and Construction Environmental Management Plan.

Traffic changes

To manage queuing and safety, there will be some temporary traffic changes and lane closures that may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Motorists are encouraged to remember PAC – Plan, Awareness, Caution.
